

# Implementation Checklist

DreamBox lessons are designed to promote learning through meaningful engagement and productive struggle. **To maximize growth, students should complete at least 5 lessons each week.** Use this checklist to guide your planning as you introduce and utilize DreamBox in your classroom this school year.

## GETTING STARTED: THE FIRST MONTH

- Log in to the DreamBox Insights Dashboard.
- Begin the self-paced onboarding course, *Getting Started with DreamBox*.\*\*\*
- Register to join a live webinar to learn how DreamBox differentiates lessons for your students and best practices for continued success.\*\*\*
- Help students log in on [iPads](#) or [computers](#).
- Introduce DreamBox to your learners. Remind students to work independently, use headphones with the volume on, and to only use the virtual manipulatives (rather than using a pencil and paper).
- Encourage students to log in and complete lessons within the first two weeks of school.
- Incorporate time into your classroom schedule and routines for students to complete at least 5 lessons each week. This generally takes about 60 minutes--which can be done during two 30-minute sessions or three 20-minute sessions.
- Communicate with families that you will be using DreamBox in your classroom this year and will share information about home usage.

## DIVING IN: THE NEXT 30-60 DAYS

- [Use the DreamBox Insights Dashboard](#) to monitor student usage and identify students who may need support.

- Use the DreamBox Insights Dashboard to inform instruction. Consider [assigning specific lessons](#) for students to complement classroom learning, help fill in gaps in understanding, or provide enrichment.
- Use DreamBox usage and insights as a springboard for conversations with families about student learning and growth.
